## **SUMMER TRAINING REPORT (STR)**

STR will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

Quality of Written Documentation (35% of total grading)

Quality of Visual Documentation (%65 of total grading)

Architectural drawings of the construction site; site photographs documenting daily process; all the visual documentation of your contribution and evaluations

# **GRADING:**

In order to successfully complete ARCH 399 Summer Practice I\_Construction Site, students must receive at least 3 points from 1.c and 1.d of SE, and complete minimum of 10 points in total from SE. Students who fail to do so are considered "Unsuccessful" and receive F (fail) grade at the end of the semester.
