



Call for Papers 16th International Conference of MEEA

The Middle East Economic Association (MEEA) is pleased to announce that it is now accepting abstracts for papers to be presented at the **16th International Conference of MEEA**, held jointly with TED University Trade Research Center in Ankara, Turkey, **May 18-20, 2017**.

The conference theme is **Trade and Inclusive Growth in the Middle East**. The meeting will have the following sub themes:

Submission Guidelines:

Your abstract and full paper should be submitted through the following web page: <http://www.tedu.edu.tr/events/meea2017/>.

Your one-page abstract should be submitted before **January 9, 2017**. Abstracts should include the papers motivations, data, methodology, expected results and conclusions. JEL classification and up to 3 keywords should be included. Conditional acceptance of abstracts for the conference will be sent to authors by **January 20, 2017**.

Your full paper should be submitted before **March 10, 2017**. Acceptance of full papers for the conference will be by **March 30, 2017**. Announcement of the program will be made by **May 5, 2017**.

Registration & Other Fees:

Registration fees to cover conference information & documentation, Gala Dinner, two lunches, and coffee breaks during the conference are as follows:

Member:

- Early registration (before April 21, 2017): \$50
- Normal registration (between April 21 and May 12): \$75
- Late and on-site registration (after May 12): \$110
- Students: \$10 (valid student ID required)

Non-Member:

- Early registration (before April 21, 2017): \$75
- Normal registration (between April 21 and May 12): \$100
- Late and on-site registration (after May 12): \$135
- Students: \$35 (valid student ID required)

Partial grants that cover accommodations only will be available on a competitive basis for Ph. D students and young scholars who obtained their PhD in the last three years. A travel grant form – available on the conference web site - has to be filled for that purpose.
