

**TED UNIVERSITY  
PROCEDURES AND PRINCIPLES  
REGARDING THE SUCCESS RANKING OF  
GRADUATES FROM UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS.**

1. Success rankings of graduates from undergraduate programs are to be determined at the end of the academic year and before the graduation ceremony.
2. All graduates in the Fall and Spring semesters of the relevant academic year are included in the assessment to determine success rankings.
3. Success rankings are based on the grades finalized by the date of the graduation ceremony. A letter stating their status is to be presented to those who are entitled for ranking upon a grade change within the scope of the regulation after the ceremony. The rights and documents given to the students who are ranked as of the date of the graduation ceremony are not to be revoked.
4. Success rankings are based on the grade point average (GPA) and those with a GPA of at least 3.00/4.00 are included in the assessment.
5. Only those who graduated in 9 semesters or less are to be included in the assessment for success ranking.
6. Top ranking students of the programs are determined among those who meet the conditions for graduation of the relevant undergraduate program. The number of graduates is also taken into account in determining the top ranking students of the program. The minimum number of graduates required to name the top ranking student of the program is determined by the University Administrative Board before the relevant graduation year.
7. The top ranking students of a faculty are determined among all the graduates of the relevant faculty who meet the required conditions.
8. The first, second and third ranking students of the university are determined among the graduates of all programs who meet the required conditions.
9. In case of a tie, multiple students may share the same degree.
10. A certificate is presented to the top ranking students. The certificate is to be signed by the rector, presented along with the diploma and specified on the diploma supplement.
